

What to see and do

More suggestions on the Stonehaven area map overleaf.

- 1 Bay Walk** Beachfront boardwalk linking the harbour to the town. Great place to watch dolphins, seals & seabirds. Note: during 2007, some parts of the Bay Walk may be disrupted due to construction work
- 2 Cowie Shore** Where the fossil of the world's oldest (428 million years old!) air-breathing creature (*Pneumodesmus Newmani*) was found
- 3 Dunnottar Woods** Lovely woodland walks at all times of year. Leaflet from Tourist Information
- 4 Harbour** Picturesque harbour, now mostly for pleasure craft. Venue for Harbour Hi-Jinks and MRI Festival (Sun, mid-late Aug) Boat trips including sea angling leave from Old Pier. Advance booking required. Contact Tourist Information for more details
- 5 Leisure Centre** Indoor sports facilities and swimming pool. Tel: (01569) 763162
- 6 Mineralwell Park** Park with play park, football pitches, large grassy areas and nice walks. Venue for Highland Games (3rd Sat in July), Firework Display (Nov), Stonehaven Juniors Football, and Stonehaven & District Model Car racing Club

- 8 Recreation Grounds** Tennis, putting, indoor & outdoor bowls. Tel: (01569) 765470
- 9 Tolbooth Museum** Open May - Oct. Wed-Mon, afternoons only. Displays about the harbour & fishing, the town's past, and temporary exhibitions
- 10 Town Hall** Venue for Folk Festival events (Thurs-Sun, early-mid July) and other concerts & ceilidhs
- 11 Walk to Dunnottar Castle & War Memorial** by the cliff path starts from here - look out for the signs
- 12 Walk to ruins of St Mary & St Nathalan's Chapel** along the cliffs starts here & from Cowie viewpoint. No signs, but path is obvious




